- 4. Econ: 0.5 credits of Personal Finance and 0.5 credits of Economics.
- Bible: 1 HS or 0.5 dual credits for every year as a full-time LUOA student. DE Bible
- 6. Health & PE: 2 credits including a minimum of 0.5 credits in each subject.
- Lang/FA/CTE: 2 credits of a lang, fine arts, or career & tech (no more than 1 credit of lang) 8
- A min of 22 total credits plus 1 Bible credit for every year as a full-time LUOA stu is required for grad.

#### **Graduation Requirements**

- 22–26 Minimum total credits.<sup>5</sup>
- **Grade of D** Minimum grade required to pass high school courses.
  - Sr Year Must be full time at LUOA.
    - 5.5 Credits must be taken at LUOA.
    - 10 Minimum dual enrollment credits required.
    - 2.5 Minimum dual enrollment credits that must be taken through LUO.
    - 25% Minimum dual enrollment courses that must be taken through LUO.
      - **2.0** Minimum dual enrollment grade point average.
- **Grad App** Must submit graduation applications within the semester of the anticipated graduation.
